**EX PARTE MOTION TO AMEND ORDER GRANTING

Maria Yip, the Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee"), for the bankruptcy estates of Providence Financial Investments, Inc. and Providence Fixed Income Fund, LLC, by and through undersigned counsel, files this Motion to Amend Order Granting Motion for Joint Administration to Correct Scriveners' Error in Case Style (the "Motion"), on an *ex parte* basis pursuant to Local Rule 9013-1(C), and in support, states as follows:

1. Maria M. Yip is the duly appointed Chapter 7 Trustee of Providence Financial Investments, Inc. and Providence Fixed Income Fund, LLC's estates (jointly, the "Debtors").

2. Upon motions filed in both of the Debtors' case, notice and hearing, on September 2, 2016, the Court entered Orders Granting Chapter 7 Trustee's Motion for Joint Administration [ECF No. 38 in Case No. 16-20516-AJC and ECF No. 31 in Case No. 16-20517-AJC].
